

The Dayton Theatre Guild

The Dayton Theatre Guild is a small theatrical company that has been producing plays since 1945 and has been at its current location, 2330 Salem Avenue in Dayton, Ohio, since 1963. The Dayton Theatre Guild, hereafter referred to as DTG, uses an all volunteer force to make their performances happen and are open to anyone who wants to participate. DTG has mounted nearly 400 productions in its 62 year history and has rarely broken their rule of repeating a production in that time.

DTG is currently raising funds to be used to relocate the theatre to a property DTG owns in downtown Dayton at Fourth and Patterson, close to Hauer Music. Funds will be used to build the new theatre which will allow DTG to house all of its props, furniture and costumes, which is considerable, under one roof, as well as creating greater exposure for the guild. DTG promises that they will maintain and continue in their tradition, a smaller theatre, as it allows for a more intimate theatrical experience.
